



LAKE LOUISA MUNICIPAL BOAT ACCESS INSTRUCTIONS

To obtain access to the Municipal Landing, a washing certificate or access permit is mandatory according to By-Law number 2015-002-001 "By-Law modifying By-Law 2015-002 on the protection of water bodies and access to Lake Louisa", users must:

1. Apply your request to an attendant working at the Boat Wash Station located at 116 Louisa Road, Wentworth (beside the Fire Hall), during its opening hours, or at the Municipal Office, 114 Louisa Road (9am-4:30pm), providing the following information:
 - a. Name, address, phone number and I.D. with picture and, if you are a seasonal resident, a supporting document such as a Tax Bill **or**:
 - b. Present a valid membership card of the "Fish and Game Club of Argenteuil", if applicable;
 - c. The description of the boat/craft, its category, brand, color, size, serial number, including the engine and, if applicable, the registration number and/or that of its vehicle and trailer;
2. Take note of this By-Law and attest to having read and agree to comply;
3. Have the craft washed and, if applicable, motor and trailer, at the Boat Wash Station by an attendant or under the supervision of the said attendant;
4. Pay the cost of the washing certificate in the amount established by By-Law as follows:
Taxpayer: \$10.00, Annual Fee for Taxpayer: \$40.00, Non-Taxpayer: \$300.00;
5. Everyone must give a deposit of \$300.00 to obtain a key for the Municipal Landing. The key will be registered in your name;
6. The key must be returned the same day to the attendant working at the Boat Wash Station located at 116 Louisa Road, Wentworth (beside the Fire Hall) during opening hours **OR** in the locked mailbox at the Municipal Office at 114 Louisa Road (9am-4:30pm), otherwise the deposit will be retained;
7. There is no parking at or near the Municipal Landing. You must take your vehicle and trailer away, and then come back to remove your boat/craft;
8. To obtain a key to remove your boat/craft, the same procedure will apply.
