



MESSAGE TO CITIZENS

Wentworth, July 29th, 2020 - These unprecedented times have made it difficult for many and the Municipality has also been faced with considerable changes in its operations.

As you may know, the Municipality requested last year the services of an engineer to prepare specifications and working plans to stabilize the outlet of Lake Louisa. It has been proposed to consolidate the section of the outlet in order to maintain the flow conditions and preserve the quality of the hydrous environment of Lake Louisa.

The municipal Council is aware that this is an important project for many and wanted to have the opportunity to present the plans to the public before requesting tenders for construction. Due to COVID-19 public information sessions could not be organized and additional delays in the approval process that were beyond our control, meant that the Municipality could not realize the project for this year.

As soon as the municipal public meetings can return to considerably normal conditions, a citizen information session will be organized to present the project and explain the procedure for the borrowing By-Law. The work will be planned for next year during the months of July and August, as required by the Ministry.

We thank-you for your understanding. The Municipality will continue to keep you informed of any advancements as the evolution of this pandemic changes rapidly.
