TENNIS COURTS ACCESSIBLE TO THE COMMUNITY OF WENTWORTH

Despite the cancellation of its SUMMER 2020 Calendar due to COVID-19, the Lake Louisa Social Club **opens access to its two (2) tennis courts** to the population of the Township of Wentworth (members and non-members) :

- **Location:** Lake Louisa Social Club - 132 Lake Louisa South Rd.
- **Schedule:** from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- **Period:** up to ~~September 1st~~, 2020
- **Matches must be limited to 45 minutes**

In order to maintain a safe environment for all players, the **posted sanitary measures must be observed**.

BY-LAW CONCERNING DOG CONTROL IN OUR TERRITORY

In order to comply with the decree of the Provincial Government concerning the control of dogs, the Municipality has updated its By-Law by adopting at its regular council meeting held on March 2nd, its new **Municipal By-Law number 2020-003, "Public Security By-Law concerning Dog Control"**.

To consult it, visit our website at www.wentworth.ca under "Communications", "Public Notices & By-Laws" or at the Town Hall during regular opening hours, Monday to Friday from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.



REMINDER: We want to remind everyone that it is important to **register your dog with the Municipality**. The cost of the licence is **\$5 per dog** and a registration form must be completed. You must also report any changes within 30 days, if applicable. If you have not already done so, please contact the municipal office at 450 562-0701 or by email at info@wentworth.ca or visit our website at www.wentworth.ca to obtain all information.

*dog owners or guardians who have their main residence elsewhere in Quebec are excluded from this obligation.



BE A RESPONSIBLE DOG OWNER

Whenever your dog is outside the limit of your property, it must **ALWAYS** be leashed and kept under control.
