### **Public hearing session on the recreational tourism development concept (Wentworth Integrated Tourism Resorts)**

A **public hearing session** on the recreational tourism development concept (Wentworth Integrated Tourism Resorts) **will be held Saturday, June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 2:00 pm at the Wentworth Community Center located at 86 Louisa Road.**

This session will allow the Township of Wentworth's Municipal Council to hear the concerns of citizens and community organizations regarding the recreational tourism development concept. Council members may also take this opportunity to ask participants questions, so that they better understand their views and comments on the matter.

This document, which will be made public, will be forwarded to the promoter to guide their work and the potential submission of a project in due form to the municipality.
