IMPORTANT : INVITATION TO AN INFORMATION MEETING

To the residents of Lac Roger and Lac Lise and other interested parties:

Having been informed of a potentially dangerous situation concerning the dam at Lac Roger, the Centre d'expertise hydrique du Québec (CEHQ) conducted a site visit on October 23rd, 2012.

Their report states that the dam is a non-conforming structure and its rupture could occur at any time. Since the owner of the dam is a bankrupt company, this orphaned structure has been recovered by Revenu Québec.

Since this high-capacity dam threatens the safety of assets and persons, and the provincial government refuses to invest to repair this type of structure used for cottage purposes, their decision is to demolish the Lac Roger dam which will certainly have an impact on Lac Lise as well. Lac Roger will revert to a watercourse.

Faced with this situation, the Municipality has commissioned the engineering firm CIMA+ to provide a counter expertise.
