PUBLIC NOTICE

**To persons interested eligible to sign a request to participate in a referendum
on the Second Draft By-Law Number 102-2016.**

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that:

- Following the Public Consultation Meeting held on July 10th, 2016, Council adopted *Second Draft By-Law Number 102-2016, Modifying Zoning By-Law Number 102*, as amended;
1. In summary, the proposed By-Law is to modify certain definitions, add or remove various development standards such as the stay for camping, implementing and building on the shoreline, including the authorized materials.
 2. This Second Draft By-Law contains provisions that can be subjected to a request to participate in a referendum by persons eligible to vote in accordance with the *Act Respecting Elections and Referendums in Municipalities* from the territory of the Municipality of the Township of Wentworth;
 3. To be valid, an application must:
 - Clearly indicate the provision of the subject and mention in respect to what the application is made;
 - Be received at the Municipal Office (114 Louisa Road) no later than **July 28th, 2016**;
 - Be signed by at least 12 interested persons from the zone where it originated or at least by the majority of them if the number of interested persons does not exceed 21.
 4. Any interested person not disqualified from voting and who fulfills the following conditions on July 10th, 2016:
 - Be of age of majority, Canadian citizen and not be under curatorship;
 - Be domiciled, property owner or occupant of a place of business in a zone where the request originates;

- Additional condition to the owners of an immovable or co-occupants of a place of business: be designated by means of a proxy signed by the majority of the co-owners or co-occupants, as the person having the right to sign the application on their behalf.
 - Additional condition of the right to sign a request by a corporation: a legal person that on July 10th, 2016 is of age of majority, a Canadian citizen and who is not under curatorship, shall be appointed by resolution among its members, directors and employees.
5. Information to determine which interested persons have the right to sign an application with respect to each of the provisions of the drafts can be obtained at the Municipal Office, between 9:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday.
 6. All the provisions of the Second Draft By-Law not subjected to a valid request can be included in a By-Law that does not have to be approved by persons eligible to vote;
 7. The Second Draft By-Laws may be consulted at the Municipal Office, between 9:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday.
