**PUBLIC NOTICE FOR ELIGIBLE VOTERS ON THE ELECTOR'S LIST
FOR REFERENDUMS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WENTWORTH**

PUBLIC NOTICE is given as follows:

At a regular meeting held on September 4th, 2018, Council adopted the Zoning By-Law Number 2018-007, Subdivision By-Law Number 2018-008 and Conditional uses By-Law Number 2018-014.

Eligible voters having the right to be on the Elector's List for referendums may request that these By-Laws be submitted to a referendum by signing a register for this purpose. Eligible voters must also enter their name, address and voter qualification.

This register will be available on October 22nd, 2018 from 9:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.
at the Municipal Office:
114 chemin Louisa
Wentworth.

The number of signatures required in order for a referendum to be held is 192. The By-Laws are deemed approved by eligible voters if said number of signatures is not achieved.

The registration procedure results will be announced on October 22nd, 2018 at 7:05 p.m., or as soon as possible thereafter, at the Municipal Office, at the above-mentioned address.

The By-Laws may be reviewed at the Municipal Office at the above-mentioned address from Monday to Friday between 9:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

In order to be an eligible voter on the Elector's List for referendums for the Municipality, the following conditions must be met:

1. All persons as of September 4th, 2018 who are not disqualified from voting according to article 524 of the Law on Elections and Referendums in Municipalities and fulfil the following conditions:
 - be domiciled in the Municipality and domiciled for at least 6 months in Québec and
 - be of full age, a Canadian citizen and not be under curatorship.
2. All non-resident sole owners of an immovable or non-resident sole occupant of a business establishment who are not convicted of an incapacity to vote and fulfil the following conditions:
 - be owner of an immovable or sole occupant of a business establishment situated in the Municipality for at least 12 months;
 - in the case of a natural person, be of full age, a Canadian citizen and not be under curatorship.
3. All undivided non-resident co-owners or non-resident co-occupants of a business establishment who are not convicted of an incapacity to vote and fulfil the following conditions:
 - Be an undivided co-owner of an immovable or co-occupant of a business establishment situated in the Municipality for at least 12 months;
 - Be designated by proxy signed by the majority of the persons who are co-owners or occupants for at least 12 months, as the person who has the right to sign the register or be on the referendum list. This proxy must be produced before or when signing the register.
4. Legal person:
 - Be designated by resolution among its members, administrators or employees a person as of September 4th, 2018 is a Canadian citizen, of full age, not convicted of an incapacity to vote and not under curatorship.

To be eligible to sign the register, an identification card must be presented. The legally accepted identification cards are Driver's Licence or Medical card issued from the Province of Québec or a Canadian Passport.
