A Solar Streetlight Now Installed at the Wentworth Township Dog Park

Township of Wentworth, Quebec — June 11, 2026 — The Township of Wentworth is pleased to announce the successful installation of a Solidel solar-powered streetlight at the dog park located on chemin du Paradis. Valued at more than \$13,000, the project was made possible through full financial support from Coop Tricentris under its *Investing in Sustainable Communities* program.

Installed in December 2025, the fully autonomous lighting system enhances safety and accessibility at the park during evening hours, particularly in seasons when darkness sets in early. Prior to this installation, the absence of lighting significantly limited the use of the site after dusk.

Powered entirely by solar energy, the new streetlight contributes to reducing the Municipality's carbon footprint and operating costs, while providing reliable, low-maintenance illumination. This initiative is fully aligned with the Municipality's commitments to sustainable development and ecological transition.

"Through our *Investing in Sustainable Communities* program, we strive to make a meaningful impact on the quality of life in the municipalities we serve. The installation of this solar streetlight at the dog park on chemin du Paradis is an excellent example. It demonstrates that it is possible, here and now, to support initiatives that combine sustainability, innovation, and community well-being," said Dany Dumont, General Manager of Coop Tricentris.

The dog park now offers a safer and more welcoming environment for the citizens and their pets. Increase in attendance during late afternoon and evening hours has already been observed. Ongoing monitoring and maintenance will be carried out by the Lac Grâce Park Committee in collaboration with municipal staff. The Township of Wentworth wishes to extend its sincere thanks to Coop Tricentris for its support through the *Investing in Sustainable Communities* program, which has led to a tangible improvement in both the usability and safety of the dog park.
