NEW – Blue bins

We wish to inform citizens that a new service is now in place for everything related to recycling bins (blue bins).

The Township of Wentworth now uses the services of USD Global for the replacement, repair or request of a new blue bin.

Citizens can now submit their applications online, at any time, through the USD Global platform.

Once the request is sent, the Municipality must authorize it before it can be officially processed.
