TOWNSHIP OF WENTWORTH**

COMING INTO EFFECT | "By-Law number 2026-002, concerning the safety, maintenance, and occupancy of heritage buildings"

Public Notice is given by the undersigned, General Manager and Clerk-Treasurer of the above-mentioned Municipality, of the coming into force of "*By-Law number 2026-002, concerning the safety, maintenance, and occupancy of heritage buildings*", which objective is:

- a) Preserve local heritage;
- b) Control situations of dilapidation and decay of buildings located within the territory of the Municipality of the Township of Wentworth;
- c) Eliminate nuisances generated by poorly maintained buildings by prescribing standards of sanitation, occupancy, and maintenance;
- d) Ensure that heritage building owners maintain their properties;
- e) When applicable, file a request with the Superior Court to have the work carried out and claim the cost as a priority debt included in the tax bill.

This By-Law came into force on February 18th, 2026, day the certificate of conformity was issued by the MRC of Argenteuil, in accordance with the Law.
