



Public notice of the revision of the list of electors

Municipality of the Township of Wentworth

Polling day: November 2nd, 2025

By this public notice, **Natalie Black, the Returning Officer**, announces the following to the electors of the Municipality:

1. The list of electors was filed with the office of the Municipality on October 1st, 2025.
It is currently under review.
2. In order to vote, you must be entered on the list of electors.
3. You have the right to be entered on the list of electors if, on polling day:
 - You are 18 years of age or older;
 - You are a Canadian citizen;
 - You have not lost the right to vote due to a tutorship;
 - You have not been convicted of a corrupt electoral practice in the previous five years.
 - In addition, you must meet **one** of the following two conditions on November 2nd, 2025:
 - Be domiciled on the territory of the Municipality and for at least six months in Québec;
 - For at least 45 days, own an immovable or occupy a business establishment located on the territory of the Municipality.

NOTE: If you are not domiciled in the municipality and want to exercise your voting right, you will need to send an application for entry or a power of attorney, as the case may be, to the returning officer.

4. You will be able to consult the list of electors on the days and during the hours indicated below. **If you are an elector domiciled in the Municipality, you will also be able to submit an application for entry**, striking or correction before the board of revisors, which sits there:

October 10th, from 9am to noon AND from 1pm to 4:30pm

- 4.1 You can apply for a revision of the list of electors **without appearing in person** if you comply with the following conditions.

How to submit the application: by videoconference using the TEAMS application

Day and time: October 8th, from 5pm to 8 pm, **by appointment** with the Returning Officer

5. If someone wishes to make an application for entry for a person domiciled in the territory of the Municipality, they must indicate that person's previous domicile address and present two documents:
 - one indicating that person's name and date of birth and the other one, their name and domicile address.
