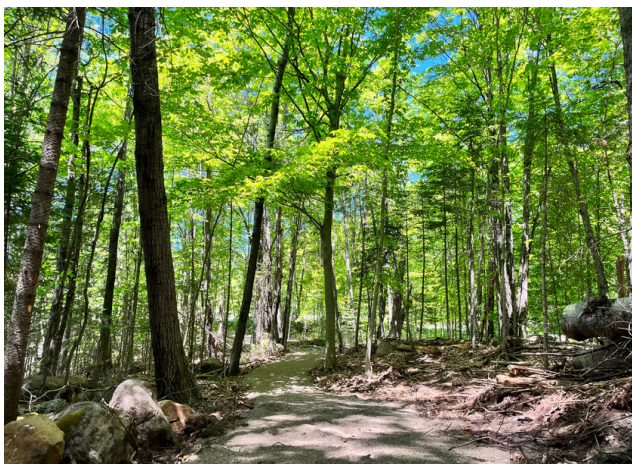

On Monday, June 2, the Municipal Council adopted a by-law on fire prevention. With the upcoming celebrations for Quebec's National Holiday and Canada Day, the Municipality reminds residents that fireworks are strictly prohibited within its territory.

Dalesville Road Loan Regulations

A loan by-law was adopted to allow for partial repairs to Dalesville Road, notably to enable a swift intervention on a culvert that required urgent attention.

The Council has authorized a loan of \$1,800,000, repayable over a period of twenty (20) years, while expressing hope that the final cost of the work will be lower than this amount.

A draft By-Law 2025-010

The municipal council invites you to review Draft By-law 2025-010 concerning the procedures for publishing public notices. For several years, the Township has been committed to an environmentally responsible approach aimed at reducing printed materials. With the redesign of the website and the arrival of Fibre Argenteuil in the area, the Township would no longer be required to post public notices on municipal bulletin boards. However, this practice may still be maintained at the discretion of the municipality. We encourage you to review the draft by-law and share your comments with us before its official adoption.
