Since 2024, three new initiatives

- 3 - Launch of a climate adaptation program focused on modernizing the road network

Evacuation instructions

- Leave quickly when asked
- Turn off the water and electricity. Turn off the gas only if the authorities specify it
- Bring your essentials:
 - Clothes for a few days, hygiene items, medicines
 - Money, cards and important documents
 - Blankets, pillows, children's toys, baby milk and diapers
- Animals: Bring them with you or place them in a safe place
- Notify the authorities if you are going to visit relatives
- Close and lock your home before leaving
- Follow official instructions: listen to media reports and follow the designated routes
