Good news! The automation of the boat wash station is in progress. Here are some important details to keep in mind based on your circumstances:

Access to the Lake Louisa Municipal Landing - Residents with stickers

- This weekend, please present to the washing station to:
 - Obtain your resident access card (free this year, as we are in a transition period).
 - Starting next year, a \$20 renewal fee will apply for the card. Please note that the access card is for exclusive use by one residence only. The Municipality will be able to track the number of times each card is used.
- The access card will allow you to open the gate.

Access to the Lake Louisa Municipal Landing - Residents without stickers

- Bring your watercraft to the washing station.
- Have your watercraft washed for \$20 per wash.
- A certificate featuring a QR code will be provided after washing, granting access to the Municipal landing.

Non-motorized Watercraft - All Lakes

Do you live near a lake other than Lake Louisa? If you own a non-motorized watercraft, washing is free at the station

Boat Wash Station Operating Hours:

• Special opening this weekend:

- Saturday and Monday, from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- The station will subsequently be accessible at all times via the automated system.
- To obtain your access card, please present yourself to the Municipal Office during opening hours.

Access Permit:

- A permit is only valid for the body of water specified in your application.
- The permit with sticker is available free of charge at the municipal office.
 - Renewal fees apply.





Step 1 - Boat Wash Station

Residents with a sticker

• This weekend, go to the Boat Wash Station to get your resident access card.

<u>Residents without a sticker</u>

- Bring your watercraft to the washing station.
- Have your watercraft washed for \$20 per wash.
- A certificate featuring a QR code will be provided after washing, granting access to the Municipal landing.

Step 2: Access to the Municipal Landing

Upon arrival at the municipal landing, present your access card or the certificate with QR code you received at the Boat Wash Station.

Please note that the certificate is valid for a single entry and exit only. This code will allow you to open the gate free of charge.
