Access to the Lake Louisa Municipal Landing

Residents with stickers

- Please present yourself at the Municipal Office during opening hours:
 - o Obtain your resident access card (free this year, as we are in a transition period).
 - Starting next year, a \$20 renewal fee will apply for the card. Please note that only one access card will be issued per residence. The Municipality will be able to track the number of uses associated with each card.

Residents without stickers

- Go to the Boat Wash Station:
 - Wash your watercraft for \$20 per wash. (debit only)
 - A certificate featuring a QR code will be provided after washing, granting access to the Municipal landing.

Non-residents

- Go to the Boat Wash Station:
 - Wash your watercraft for \$50 per wash. (debit only)
 - A certificate featuring a QR code will be provided after washing, granting access to the Municipal landing.

Non-motorized Watercraft - All Lakes

• Each time you change lakes, please go to the Boat Wash Station to clean your watercraft. **Washing is free for non-motorized watercraft.**

Boat Wash Station Operating Hours:

- The Boat Wash Station is accessible at all times via the automated system.
- To obtain your access card, please present yourself to the Municipal Office during opening hours.

Access Permit:

- A permit is only valid for the body of water specified in your application.
- The permit with sticker is available free of charge at the Municipal Office.
 - Renewal fees apply.





Step 1 - Boat Wash Station

Residents with a sticker

Go to Municipal Office to get your resident access card.

Residents without a sticker

- Bring your watercraft to the Boat Wash Station.
- Wash your watercraft for \$20 per wash (debit only).
- A certificate featuring a QR code will be provided after washing, granting access to the Municipal Landing.

Non-Residents

- Bring your watercraft to the Boat Wash Station.
- Wash your watercraft for \$50 per wash (debit only).
- A certificate featuring a QR code will be provided after washing, granting access to the Municipal Landing.

Step 2: Access to the Municipal Landing

Upon arrival at the Municipal Landing, present your access card or the certificate with QR code you received at the Boat Wash Station. Please note that the certificate is valid for a single entry and exit only. This code will allow you to open the gate.
